On July 27, 1968, 172 candidates were initiated by the Parker, Arizona Lodge Officers.

Meetings were held any place that was available at the time until a small building was purchased on Mulberry Ave. Membership continued to grow and in 1973 the present lodge property was purchased and the cornerstone of the building was laid with mostly volunteer labor.

Since that time we have grown to almost 4,000 members and have been awarded “**All American Lodge**” six times by the Grand Lodge.
