In the coming months we will be completing the Construction Phase drawings for the Lodge Expansion. You will see contractors coming and going in the process. The next steps for moving forward are:

1. Complete the Construction Phase drawings
2. Provide a complete application package for the bank loan
3. Submit to Grand Lodge for approval
4. Start the permitting process

All of these steps must be complete before any construction begins. As a Lodge we must follow the steps to get all approvals complete so it will not be immediate.

In the meantime we are still asking for your donations to support the Building fund. The more we have the less we borrow. That is a cost savings in itself! Any amount is appreciated. Thank you to all that have been so generous to give.

We will continue to update you through Lodge meetings, website and Wapiti. Please help us stop rumors and misinformation by attending Lodge meetings or referring to the updates provided. As always the committee and I are available to answer any questions.
