



Project Plans Nearing Completion!

The Lodge Planning Committee met with the Architect of the expansion project on January 17th to review the current construction drawings. The Planning Committee should have the completed plans in hand by January 26th!

Once in hand, the lodge can apply for the building permit with the city and a construction loan from a local bank. Foothills Bank has been very cooperative in the process so far.

Commercial permits and commercial loans take about the same amount of time to acquire, so we are optimistic of breaking ground by late June or early July.

The project was delayed last summer due to unforeseen circumstances which did move us back a bit in the construction line-up of local projects.

Sadly, the lodge has been notified of an untrue rumor floating around that the permit was denied by the city. That is impossible since the lodge has not applied for a permit yet! The lodge has been working with local contractors and Architect that are very experienced with local building codes. We are confident the process will go smoothly. Please attend lodge meetings, rather than listening to bogus rumors. Thanks,
