



Update March 8, 2024 **Project Plans Complete!**

The Lodge Planning Committee has all of the stamped project and steel plans in hand. The project Architect will now assist with applying for the building permit with the city.

A loan application was submitted to Foothills Bank on Friday, March 8th. Commercial loans take approximately eight weeks to process.

The Committee is still planning to break ground by early July.

With the major part of the construction happening during the slower months, disruption to the club operation should be minimal.
